Camping & General

- a sleeping bag
- sleeping mat
- Camping pillow
- Fuel Friend II
- tent
- Tension straps thin
- Packing net
- First aid pack and high visibility vest
- Map material, in case YOU are oldschool
- LED headlamp
- (Bluetooth Box mini or headphones)
- Camera (maybe compact)
- Smartphone with charger
- Money, credit card, etc.
- Passport, driver's license, vehicle documents and green card
- Clothes, shoes, towels, bathing suit, flip flops, etc.
- light waterproof jacket
- rain suit
- Shampoo, hand wash, cream, etc. (small bottles)
- toothbrush and toothpaste
- baby wipes, Zewa
- possibly e-book reader
- odds and ends (pens, notebooks, etc.)
- possibly umbrella (peaked)
- Charging cable for all electronics
- Powerbank (maybe with compressor)

Kitchen

- Food (apples, cereals, bread, (soy) milk, noodles, bagged soups, tea, espresso powder, cornflakes, Desperados, ...)
- Camping utensils (trekking)
- Thermos jug, stainless steel 0,5 l
- Gas stove trekking with cartridge
- Garbage bag

Check before tour

- Tire pressure and tread
- enough 2-stroke oil with it
- tank full
- suitable gloves
- tube scarf
- rain suit, safety vest, first aid kit
- all lights, indicators and horn are working

Tool

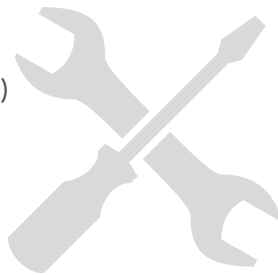
- Screwdriver Phillips + Normal
- Open-end spanner 7-13
- Spark plug spanner
- small ratchet box
- a set of cables and screw nipples
- WD40, small bottle
- tube of cold metal
- spare spark plug
- spare clutch (for long tours)
- various cable ties
- Binding wire (1 m)
- Cable (0.75, 2 m)
- Liquid metal (2K)

- **Special tools:**
Pole wheel puller, clutch puller

- Multitool
- Spare manifold gasket, set of main jets (various sizes)
- small roll of universal fabric tape* (Gaffa Tape, Panzertape)
- Roll of insulating tape
- 1 pair of work gloves
- several tea lights (for the male romance ;-))
- 2 pairs of disposable gloves
- rag
- Spare loo roll (packed waterproof)
- several metres of paracord (thin rope)
- check spare wheel for air
- golden credit card AND ADAC Plus card ;-)

Spare parts

1. for smaller tours up to 500 km:

- 1 Clutch cable
- 2 shift cables
- 1 throttle cable
- 1 front brake cable
- 1 rear brake cable
- 2 screw nipples
- 1 spark plug
- 1 ignition cable with plug
- 1 set of bulbs

2. for tours 500 up to 5000 km extended by:

- 1 spare hose
- 1 coupling
- 1 CDI
- 2nd spark plug
- 1 m cable and luster terminals
- 1 armour tape
- 1 m wire

3. for long distance travel (10,000+), especially to sparsely populated countries:

- 1 Clutch cable complete
- 2 clutch cables
- 2 shift cables complete
- 4 shift cables
- 1 handbrake cable complete, front
- 2 handbrake cables, front
- 1 foot brake cable complete
- 1 foot brake cable
- 1-2 spare tyres
- 2 spare hoses
- 3rd spark plugs
- 1 ignition base plate
- 1 voltage regulator (if applicable)
- 1 piston incl piston rings
